- 2. Academic Achievement:** Please identify your grade point average and your weighted grade point average. You must have at least a weighted grade point average of 3.0 to be considered for this scholarship. Please attach a copy (photocopy is acceptable) of your unofficial transcript of all courses taken through the first semester of your senior year.
- 3. Community and Family Service:** Please describe how you were involved in community and/or family service both through RM (Student Service Learning Hours) as well as any service provided to outside of RM. **(Limit your description to one page.)**
- 4. Extra-Curricular Activities:** Please identify any extra-curricular activities both within RM and outside of RM which you feel are relevant and important to your growth as a student at RM. Examples include: Jobs, Scouting, Model United Nation participation, internships, club activities, etc. Please identify **any leadership positions** you held in these activities.

### Interview
